## HOW TO BOOK YOUR TRIP

- 1. Contact Us:** We are available to answer your questions and to check availability.
- 2. Interview:** A five minute interview is required to establish your level of enthusiasm, help you decide if AAVE is right for you, match your age with an appropriate group and warn you about alcohol, drugs, tobacco, detrimental behavior and the rules which unify our community. A copy of these rules (PUA) will be faxed or emailed to you at your request.
- 3. Submit an \$800 deposit and application:** Openings are available on a first come basis. Depending on availability, we may only be able to hold you a space for 24 hours allowing you to over night your application and deposit. Full tuition is due May 15.

- 4. Acceptance:** We will send you an immediate written confirmation with a detailed clothing list, reading list, medical form, insurance form and participation agreement. Your references will be contacted by mail.
- 5. Air Travel:** Our travel office will try to fly you with other trip members. AAVE meets every teenager at the airport upon arrival where a call home occurs. Arrival and departure times are very strict. There is a minimum \$150 charge for arrival or departure that does not strictly meet our guidelines.
- 6. Final Packet:** Two weeks departure we will mail you a group list, leader description, detailed itinerary, flight list and instructions and final papers.
- 7. Contact Us Again!** We embrace our responsibility to answer your questions. It is our goal to exceed your expectations for communication and guardianship.
